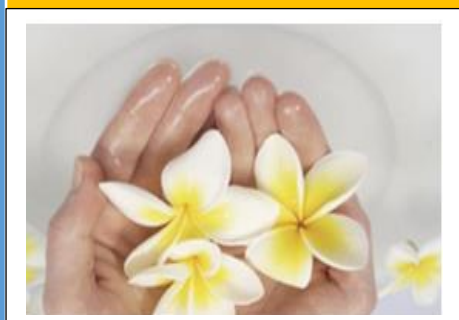

TIMELINE OF SHIVAJI MAHARAJ

1627 - Shivaji born in the hill fort of Shivner

1643-47 - Shivaji overran the hill forts of Kondana, Torana and Raigarh

1647 - Shivaji's Guardian Dadaji Khondev died

1656 - Shivaji conquered Javli from Chandra Rao More

1657 - Shivaji came into conflict with the Moghuls for the first time by making raids into Ahmednagar.

1659 - Afzal Khan of Bijapur was killed by Shivaji

1660 - Moghul Governor Shaista Khan occupied Pune

1663 - Shivaji made an attack on Shaistakhan's harem and wounded him

1664 - Shivaji raided and looted Surat

1665 - Jai Singh besieged the fort of Purandar and forced Shivaji to sign the treaty of Purandar

1666 - Shivaji escaped from Agra

1670 - Shivaji attacked Surat for the second time.

1674 - Shivaji crowned himself at Raighad and assumed the title of Maharaja Chhatrapati

1676 - Shivaji's last campaign against Jijapuri Karnataka. Captured Jinji and Vellore

1680 - Shivaji died.

BATTLES OF SHIVAJI MAHARAJ

Name of Battle	Fought on	Battle With
Battle of Pratapgad	November 10, 1659	Adilshahi general Afzal Khan
Battle of Kolhapur	December 28, 1659	Adilshahi forces
Battle of Pavan Khind	July 13, 1660, at a, India	Between the Maratha Sardar Baji Prabhu Deshpande and Siddi Masud of Adilshah
Battle of Chakan	1660.	Fought between the Maratha Empire and the Mughal Empire
Battle of Umerkhind	2 February 1661	between the Maratha under Chhatrapati Shivaji and the Kartalab Khan of Mughals
Sacking of Surat	January 5, 1664,	Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and Inayat Khan, a Mughal captain.
Battle of Purandar	in 1665.	Fought between the Mughal Empire and Maratha Empire
Battle of Sinhagad	4 February 1670,	Tanaji Malusare, a commander of Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj and Udaybhan Rathod fort keeper under Jai Singh I who was a Mughal Army Chief.
Battle of Kalyan	1682-nd 1683	Maratha Army and Bahadur Khan of the Mughal Empire
Battle of Bhupalgarh	1679	Mughal and Maratha empires
Battle of Sangamner	1679.	Mughal Empire and Maratha Empire This was the last battle in which the Maratha King Shivaji fought

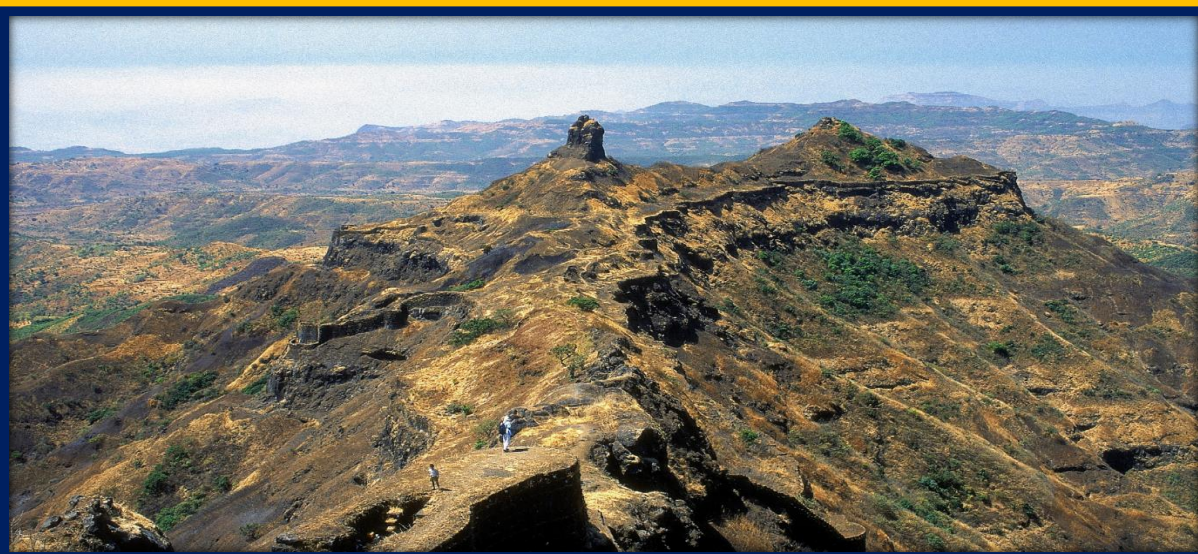
Forts That Prove Shivaji Maharaj Was The Greatest Ruler Maharashtra Ever Had

Shivneri



A 17th century fort, Shivneri is the birthplace of Shivaji Maharaj.

Torna



Torna was Shivaji's premiere conquest at the young age of 16

Sinhagad



"Gad aala, pan Sinha gela"

Vijaydurg



Vijaydurg is considered one of Shivaji's best victories

Pratapgad



Pratapgad is famous for the encounter between Shivaji and the mighty Afzal Khan

Lohagad



Having conquered this fort twice by Shivaji Maharaj, Lohagad held its prime importance due to its strategic location

Sindhudurg



A powerful naval base for the Maratha Kingdom

Raigad



Royal coronation of Shivaji Maharaj as the official king of the Maratha Empire took place at Raigad fort and Shivaji Maharaj breathed his last in this fort.
