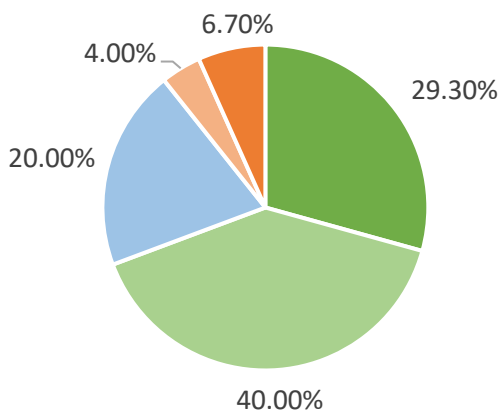

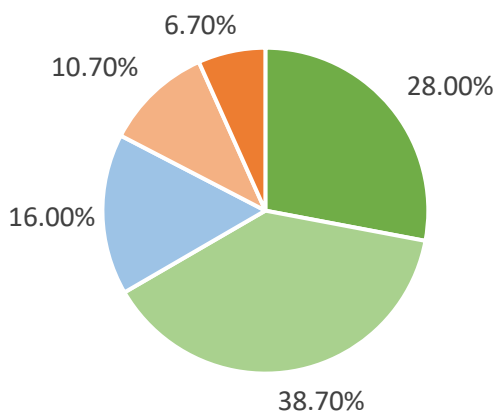
CRITERIA 1 – FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM 2023-24 – ALUMNI

1. Feedback Criteria: How do you rate the curriculum prescribed for your degree during your term in the college?



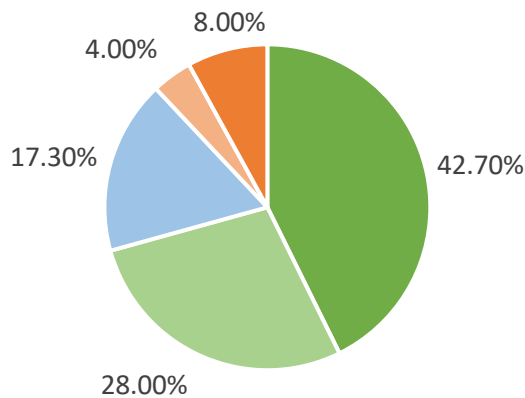

2. Feedback Criteria: Did the curriculum fulfilled your expectations?



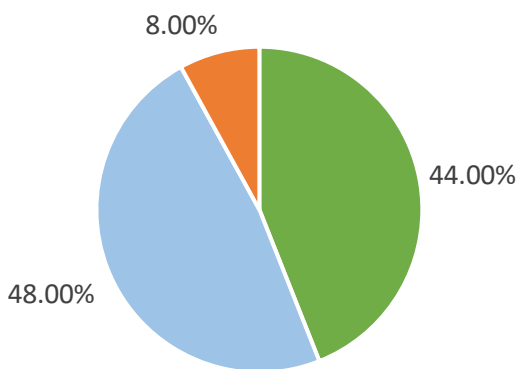

3. Feedback Criteria: How do you rate the course/syllabus that have increased your knowledge and understanding the subjects which you have studied during the term of your college



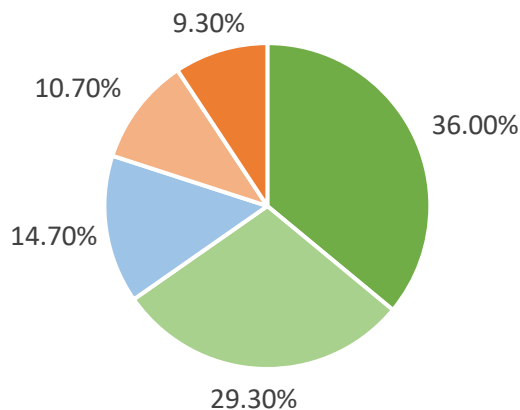
