



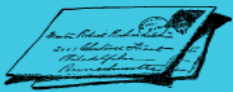

'THINKERS BANK'

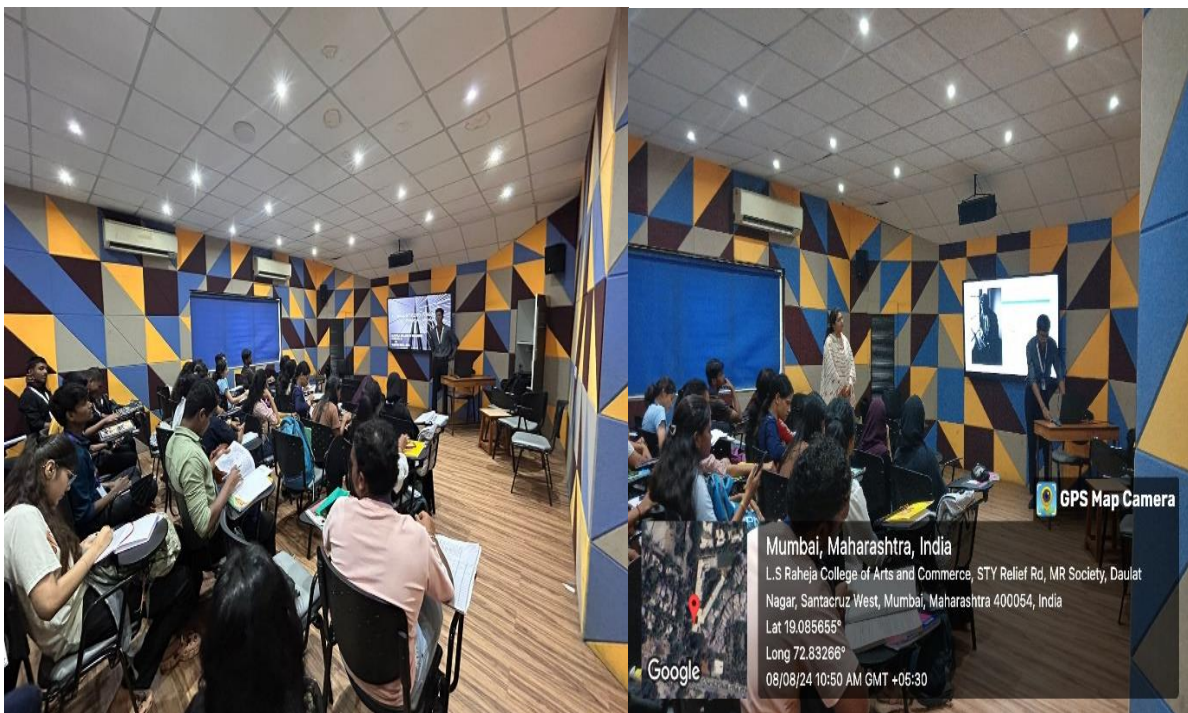

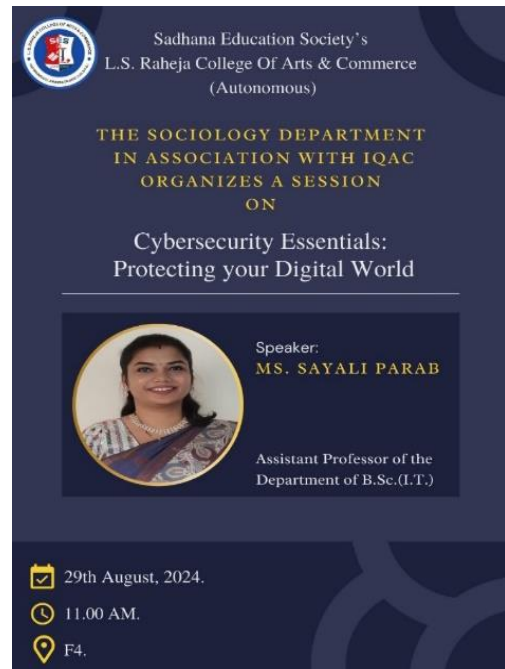
GUEST SESSION ON 'PRACTICAL INSIGHT INTO CONDUCTING RESEARCH

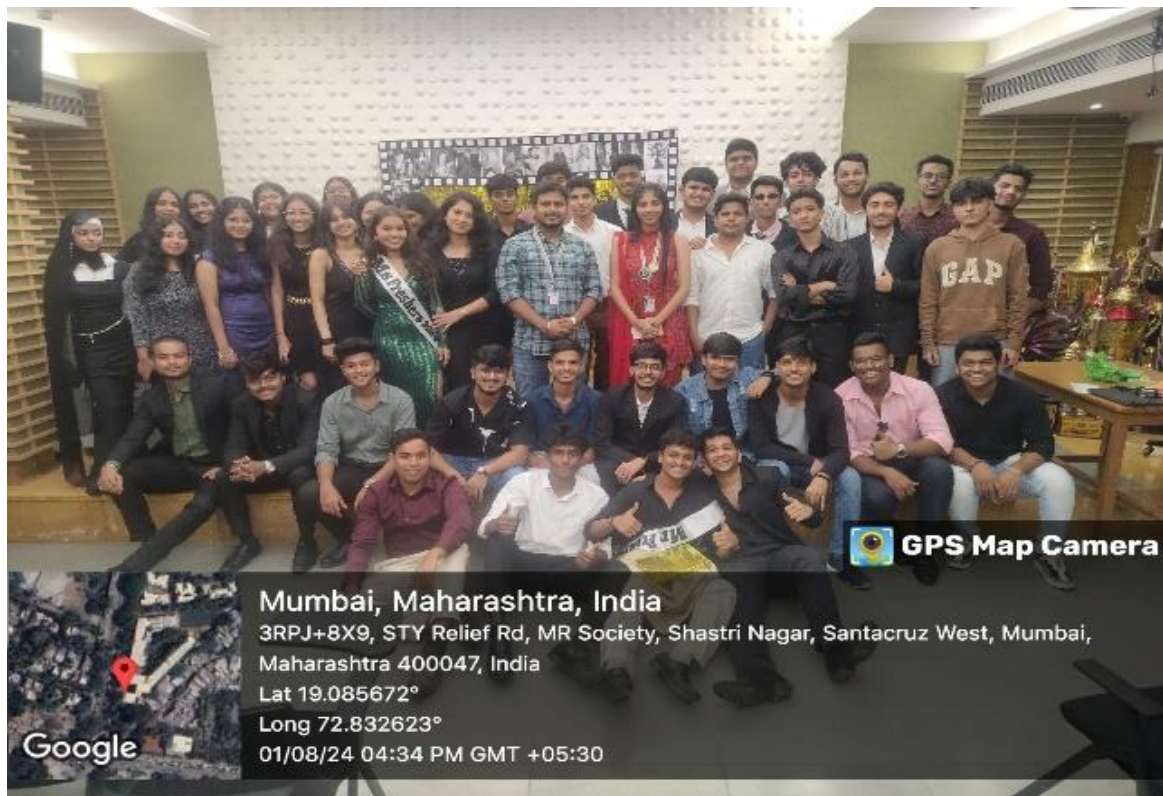

The Cultural Committee organized Independence Day was celebrated by all the members of college.



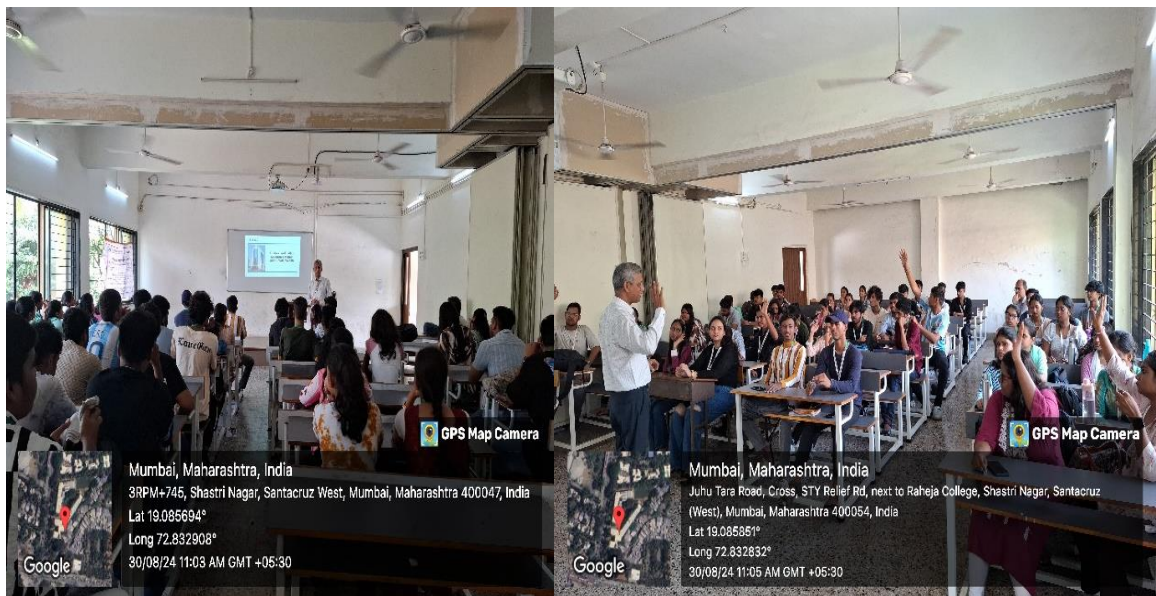
GURU PURNIMA CELEBRATION
